The day called for a 20% chance of precipitation which unfortunately kept away a few of our regulars. Well it never rained but it was overcast all day. There seemed to be a tremendous 1 mph breeze at times which was just enough for me to need to hold a touch for the wind on the longer shots although that did bite me once when the pellet went exactly where aimed and on the face plate. In most cases holding that little bit out of the Kill Zone paid off as the only long target I missed was the one just mentioned.

We had 3 new shooters (Wen Junction, Patrick Clifford, and Joseph Murphy) all sharing the same gun in the Pistol Class. I commend each and every one of them for not only shooting their first Field Target Match with a Pistol but also with open sights and a multi pump pistol at that. Needless to say if that Crossman 1377 wasn't broken in before the match it sure was by the end of it with all that pumping.

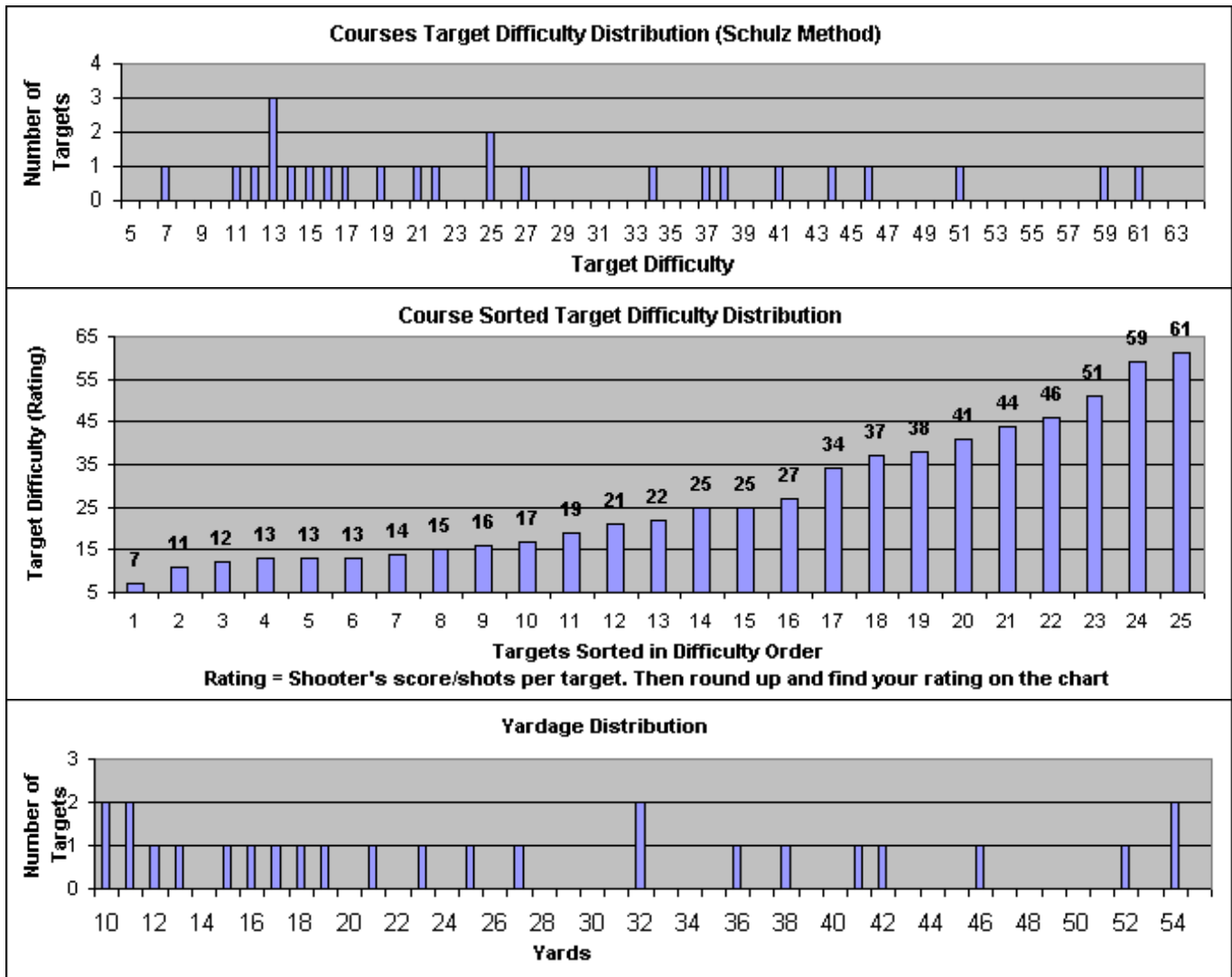
The largest attended class was the Off-Hand Class and Gopal Jambavat shot the Match High Score Standing!!! Gopal doesn't get out to shoot much, but when he does he blows everyone away. Jock Elliott shot an R1 in the Hunter Class but with no Glass. He used Peep Sights and Won!! Very Impressive. Paul Cray and Paul Bishop (who placed 1st and 2nd in the Piston Class at the Nationals respectively) had a very close match with Paul Bishop edging Paul Cray out by One point for NYS Spring Gun Class Champion.

Congratulations to the NY State FT Champions, Joe Dennis – Open Class Champion, Paul Bishop – Spring Gun Class Champion, Bridget Bowne – Junior Class Champion, Gopal Jambavat – Off-Hand Class Champion, Jock Elliott – Hunter Class Champion, and Junction Wen – Pistol Class Champion.

We had a 50/50 drawing after the match was complete. The shortest person there always draws the tickets. This time Venkat drew his father's ticket. Good Job Venkat. This was also the last match that qualified for the Free Air Rifle Raffle. There were 7 matches that qualified the participants to win a free Air Rifle donated by Airguns of Arizona (the donated gun was a Webley Exocet). Each match participant received a free raffle ticket at each qualifying match that they shot in. No tickets were sold for this raffle. The only way to have a chance at winning was to participate at any or all of the matches. Obviously the more matches a shooter participated in the better the odds that they would win. Also if a shooter participated in 2 classes at the same match he got 2 raffle tickets. The idea was to promote Field Target and increase participation. Again Venkat was asked to draw a ticket and this time he Drew Hans Apelles's Ticket. Hans was not able to attend the match due to having his replaced hip replaced again. Hans was still recovering in the hospital from his surgery just 3 days earlier. I called Hans after the match and Hans wanted me to thank Airguns of Arizona for donating the Exocet and all of the shooters for participating at our matches.

Thanks to everyone that helped pull in targets. Many hands make light work and it is greatly appreciated. A Special Thanks to Paul Bishop for coming a day early and helping setup the match the day before.
